A Retreat for Priests Focused on the Sacred Liturgy

During the "Year For Priests," the Liturgical Institute proudly presents its first spiritual retreat for priests. Intended to combine theological and practical aspects of liturgy with prayer and meditation, the retreat takes place on the beautiful campus of the University of Saint Mary of the Lake just outside of Chicago.

Spiritual master **Fr. Lawrence Hennessey** of Mundelein Seminary offers a retreat centered on the mystery of Christ disclosed by the Holy Spirit in the mission of a priest. Using the various invocations of the Holy Spirit (*epiklesis*) during the course of the Eucharistic Liturgy as a framework, it will pay special attention to the "practical," everyday implementation of biblical, theological, and spiritual principles in the lived reality of a priest's life and ministry. With a special lecture by **Archbishop Charles J. Chaput** of Denver.



The retreat includes:

- Spiritual conferences and daily Mass
- Chanted morning and evening prayer in the Chapel of the Immaculate Conception (left)
- Solemn Mass for the Nativity of John the Baptist with special schola directed by composer **Kevin Allen** of Chicago
- Beautiful setting with time for prayer and meditation

- Confession and spiritual direction as desired
- Hillenbrand Lecture with **Archbishop Charles J. Chaput** of Denver



Fr. Lawrence Hennessey is professor of Systematic Theology at Mundelein Seminary where he has taught and provided spiritual direction for nearly 20 years. He holds a doctorate of Sacred Theology in Classical Philology and Early Christian Theology from the Catholic University of America and is the editor of the theological journal *Chicago Studies*. Known as a spiritual master who combines substantive content

with a gentle manner, Fr. Hennessey will provide a thought-provoking and spiritually nourishing retreat for priests.
